The meeting was called to order at 9:00 am by Alberta Ridlon, Town Clerk with The Pledge of Allegiance.

WARRANT FOR TOWN MEETING

To <u>Kim Ashley</u>, Constable of the Town of Sweden, County of Oxford, State of Maine, GREETINGS: In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sweden in said county, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet at Sweden Town Meeting House, in said Town, on <u>Saturday</u>, the <u>26th day of March AD 2016</u>, at <u>nine o'clock in the morning</u>, then and there to act on the following Articles, to wit:

Article 1. To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.
